Job Centre Plus Support for Schools was a manifesto commitment in 2015. The intention is to assist schools in England to deliver their statutory duty to provide high quality, independent and impartial careers advice and information for school years 8 to 13 (aged 12 -18) and up to aged 24 for SEND students.

This will add value in three broad areas.

- Providing advice on routes into Traineeships, Apprenticeships and T Levels.
 - Preparation and information for Work Experience.
- Providing advice on the Local Labour Market (including soft skills employers value, such as teamwork and commitment)

My support is expected to be demand-led by schools, responsive and flexible, and could include any, or all of the following;

- Advice and Information with the job application process - CVs, applications, mock interviews
- Supporting schools in sourcing appropriate companies for skills fairs
- Attending Careers/Jobs Fairs to offer help and advice and careers with the Civil Service
- Labour market upskilling, for pupils and/or teachers/parents
- Employability Workshops
- Social Media Presentations
- Apprenticeship / Traineeships / T Levels
- Options and Choices
